Proposed regional facility is on an existing landfill that has a RCRA Subtitle D liner suitable for managing municipal solid waste and has permitted airspace available for disposal.



The facility has state-of-the-art environmental protections with ground water monitoring and leachate collection.



Our operations partner, Dem-Con, has a demonstrated track record in waste processing and recycling at its Environmental Campus in Shakopee, Minnesota.



On-site existing recycling is supported by Dem-Con's existing green infrastructure at their Environmental Campus.
