On behalf of Minnesota Famers Union (MFU), I write to share our support for Senator Gustafson's bill (SF3528) to ensure that home-based early care facilities can benefit from our nation leading farm-to-school program. This program is a win-win-win for farmers, families, and the state providing a reliable market for farmers while ensuring that the youngest Minnesotans have access to healthy, local, food.

MFU is a grassroots organization that has represented Minnesota's family farmers, ranchers and rural communities since 1918. Our members are excited about our state's work to build out farm to school and early care programming because these initiatives stand to improve local markets for the food they work hard to produce. These programs can also help small and beginning farmers earn a fair price and access institutional markets. That's why our members were quick to lift up policy in strong support of this work during our grassroots policy development process.
