# Minnesota's evolving conservation approach



## 2023: An exciting year for conservation delivery and more







## Former approach

- Districts pursue competitive grants to fund one-time projects
- Responsive approach



### New approach

- Partnerships put WBIF funding toward highestpriority needs within watershed
- Strategic approach: prioritized, targeted and measurable



## Former approach

- Local collaboration
- Two-year grant cycles



## New approach

- Local and regional collaboration
- Four-year cycles for certain grants

# Unprecedented funding for this expanded scope

#### New funding allocated in 2023 for...

## Soil health


- \$12 million (Clean Water Fund)
- \$21 million (General Fund)
- \$25 million (NRCS RCPP)
- \$15 million (federal climate smart funding)



# BWSR Soil Health funding: Soil Health Staffing Grants

#### RFP opened Nov. 15; closed Feb. 8

- Support additional local capacity
- Funding specifically for staffing and increasing soil healthrelated expertise for SWCDs



# BWSR Soil Health funding: Soil Health Delivery Grants

# Funds slated to be allocated Winter-Spring 2024

- Grants can be used for staffing, practices, and outreach
- Minimum \$4 million will be awarded



# BWSR Soil Health funding: Soil Health Practices Grants

# Funds slated to be allocated Spring-Summer 2024

- Focus on practice implementation and landowner incentives
- Funding comes from \$25 million RCPP grant from NRCS




# BWSR Soil Health funding: Alliance to Advance Climate-Smart Agriculture

## RFP opened December 2023 for 8-10 SWCDs

\$2.5 million available to prepare SWCDs to help landowners with incentive payments

\$13 million available in the future for direct payments to landowners. \$100 per acre or animal unit.



# Unprecedented funding for this expanded scope

### New funding allocated in 2023 for...

#### Water storage

- \$17 million (general fund)
- Water Quality and Storage Grant application recently opened




# Water Quality and Storage Program

### Focus on climate resiliency

#### Goals

- Increase water storage capacity
- Control water rates
- Protect infrastructure



# Unprecedented funding for this expanded scope

#### New funding allocated in 2023 for...

#### **Pollinator habitat**

- \$4 million for Lawns to Legumes (general fund)
- \$1 million for Habitat
   Friendly Utilities Program
   (general fund)
- \$4 million for Habitat
   Enhancement Landscape
   Program (general fund)




# BWSR Pollinator Habitat Funding: Lawns to Legumes

More than 5,000 projects installed across the state

Projects funded in all 87 counties

32 demonstration neighborhood grants awarded to build pollinator pathways



# BWSR Pollinator Habitat Funding: HELP Program

Provides financial and technical assistance to establish habitat on existing conservation lands, such as easements




## BWSR Pollinator Habitat Funding: Habitat Friendly Utilities

Provides financial and technical assistance to establish habitat within solar, wind, pipeline and electrical transmission corridors





# Minnesota's Watershed-Based Approach


