



S.F. No. 4359 – Modifying county share requirement for SNAP administrative costs

Section 1 (amends Minn. Stat. § 142A.03, subdivision 2) requires the commissioner of children, youth, and families to bear the total amount of any disallowance or sanction for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and makes technical and conforming changes.

Section 2 (adds Minn. Stat. § 142F.05, subdivision 5) prohibits a county agency from contributing any more than 50 percent of the total SNAP administrative costs and requires the commissioner to reimburse each county agency for the difference between the federal reimbursement and the county administrative cost share.

Section 3 (amends Minn. Stat. § 256.017, subdivision 2) updates a cross-reference clarifying that “commissioner” for the purposes of section 256.017 means the commissioner of children, youth, and families.

Section 4 (amends Minn. Stat. § 256.017, subdivision 10) removes the requirement that county funds must cover the cost of any penalties.
