



## **S.F. No. 3657, as amended by the A-2 – DISABILITY WAIVER RATE SYSTEM UNIT-BASED SERVICES WITH PROGRAMMING LIMITS MODIFICATION**

S.F. 3657, as amended by the A-2 amendment, amends **256B.4914, subdivision 8 - Unit-based services with programming; component values and calculation of payment rates**, by modifying the monthly and daily distribution of permitted billable units of individualized home supports with training and individualized home supports with family training. The bill also creates a new exception to the billing limit.

The bill as amended retains the current law annual limit on billable units of home supports with training and individualized home supports with family training. For individualized with training, the bill eliminates the daily limit of six hours per day and replaces that limit to a monthly limit but still constrains the monthly limit to the number of hours equal to an average of 6 hours per day. For both individualized home supports with training and individualized home supports with family training, the bill as amended eliminates the current law prohibition on billing for more than 3 consecutive hours.

The bill as amended eliminates the billing limit for individualized home supports with training and individualized home support with family training provided to any individual who has complex behavioral health needs or complex medical needs.
