1.3 "Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 116P.09, subdivision 6, is amended to read:

1.4 Subd. 6. **Conflict of interest.** (a) A commission member, a technical advisory committee
1.5 member, a peer reviewer, or an employee of the commission may not participate in or vote
1.6 on a decision of the commission, advisory committee, or peer review relating to an
1.7 organization in which the member, peer reviewer, or employee has either a direct or indirect
1.8 personal financial interest. While serving on the commission or technical advisory committee
1.9 or as a peer reviewer or while an employee of the commission, a person must avoid any
1.10 potential conflict of interest.

1.11 (b) A commission member may not ~~vote on a motion regarding the purchase of land~~
1.12 ~~under section 116P.18 or the final recommendations of the commission required under~~
1.13 ~~section 116P.05, subdivision 2, paragraph (a), if the motion relates to an organization in~~
1.14 ~~which the member has a direct personal financial interest. If a commission member is~~
1.15 ~~prohibited from voting under this paragraph, the number of affirmative votes required under~~
1.16 ~~section 116P.05, subdivision 2, paragraph (a), or section 116P.18 is reduced by the number~~
1.17 ~~of members ineligible to vote under this paragraph~~ serve as a project manager for or receive
1.18 financial or other compensation from a proposal that is being reviewed by the commission
1.19 or receiving money from the trust fund.

1.21 Sec. 4. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 116P.18, is amended to read:

1.22 **116P.18 LANDS IN PUBLIC DOMAIN.**

1.23 Money appropriated from the trust fund must not be used to purchase any land in fee
1.24 title or a permanent conservation easement if the land in question is fully or partially owned
1.25 by the state or a political subdivision of the state or was acquired fully or partially with state
1.26 money, unless:

1.27 (1) the purchase creates additional direct benefit to the protection, conservation,
1.28 preservation, and enhancement of the state's air, water, land, fish, wildlife, and other natural
1.29 resources; and

1.30 (2) the purchase is approved, prior to the acquisition, by an affirmative vote of at least
1.31 11 members of the commission, ~~except as provided under section 116P.09, subdivision 6,~~
1.32 ~~paragraph (b).~~
